



ST ANDREWS ANGLING CLUB FUNDING JUNE 2019

East Fife Sports Council (EFSC) was delighted to support St Andrews Angling Club with funding in June, after being contacted by the club about the final fundraising push for a Wheelyboat. This is a boat that is adapted for taking wheelchairs and allows people to go fishing or simply to access and enjoy being in a boat. The Angling Club (www.standrewsanglingclub.co.uk) was working with the Wheelyboat Trust, a charity involved in supplying these boats to stillwater fisheries and promoting freedom and independence on the water for disabled people of all ages. Having already fundraised a five-figure sum through club donations and grants from the St Andrews Community Fund and the University of St Andrews, the Angling Club needed to secure another £1000, contacting EFSC for advice on further funding streams. As a member of EFSC it was able to apply for a sports council development grant, which was unanimously supported by the grants committee. The EFSC committee look forward to hearing more about this exciting, forward-thinking project, and wish the club the very best with its plans and development.
